**Subject : Scheme of pre-matric scholarship for students belonging to the minority communities of Christians & Muslims : advertisement thereof**

Applications are invited from the students belonging to the minority communities notified by the Central Government, pursuing education, from Class 1 upto Class 10, in Government Schools/Institute or Private school recognised or permitted by the Government for Pre-matric scholarship to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. Application in the prescribed format given at the end of this advertisement (also available at <http://nagaland.nic.in>) along with requisite documents shall be submitted by the Student to the respective District Education Officer and for Kiphire, Longleng & Peren districts to the Dy. Inspector of Schools concern by 18<sup>th</sup> September 2009 through the Head of the School /Institute being attended or last attended by the student. Completed forms shall be submitted to the Directorate of School Education on or before 25<sup>th</sup> September 2009.

**1. Object**

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarship to the meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority communities to enable them to pursue education from Class I to Class X.

**2. Scope**

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India only and district-wise nos. of students allocated by Government of India vide No.12/3/2009-PP(PPR) dated 16<sup>th</sup> June 2009 for 2009-10 is as follow :

Note. The break-up is workout from 2008 enrolment and on the basis of percentages of ST for Christians and Muslims as per 7<sup>th</sup> AIES.

### 3. **Conditions For Scholarship:**

- i. Scholarship will be given to the students, pursuing studies from Class I to Class X, in Government and Govt. recognized and permitted private schools in the State.
- ii. To be eligible, students should have not have less than 50% marks in the previous final examination. In the case of students of Class I, the income criteria only would be applicable.
- iii. The annual income for all sources, of the students' parents or guardian should not exceed Rs.1.00 lakh. Inter-se selection weightage is to be given to poverty rather than marks.
- iv. 30% of scholarships will be earmarked for girl students. In case girl students are not available then the scholarships earmarked for them will be awarded to eligible boy students.
- v. The award will be discontinued if a student fails to secure 50% marks in the annual examination and 80% attendance except in case of unavoidable reason to be certified by the Principal/competent authority of the school and recommended by the State Government.
- vi. Students should be regular in attendance and must secured 80% attendance to be eligible for renewals
- vii. Income certificate should be on self-certification basis by way of affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper to be countersigned by the Administrative Officer not below the rank of EAC for farmers & self-employed parents/guardian and employer for employed parents/guardian.
- viii. The School/Institute will certify the claim of student in case of outstation student not residing in hostel of the school/Institute concerned on the basis of permanent address and parents' address.
- ix. If a student violates school discipline or any other terms and conditions, circumstances and are in the interest of student's academic career, scholarship shall be suspended or cancelled.
- x. If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered.
- xi. Course fee/Tuition fee will be credited to the School's/Institute's bank account in favour of the Student. **Therefore the School/Institute must have accounts with any of the nationalized bank preferably with State Bank of India.** Efforts will be made for transferring it electronically through the banks.
- xii. Maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's bank account. **Therefore student concern must open accounts with any of the nationalized bank preferably with State bank of India.** Efforts will be made for transferring it electronically through the bank.
- xiii. The students obtaining benefits under this scheme shall not be allowed to avail benefits under any other scheme for this purpose.
- xiv. A students shall be eligible for only one scholarship for all sources i.e., SC/ST/OBC.

### 4 **DURATION:**

Maintenance allowance shall be given for 10 months only in an academic year.

5 **RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

Actual financial assistance will be provided for admission/tuition fee and maintenance allowance as given below subject to a maximum ceiling indicated against item concerned.
